

# NOVEMBER AND DECEMBER 2008

## GENERAL DIRECTIONS

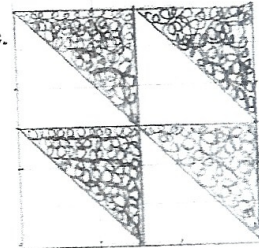
Color A will be your background color. Next to each color designation(A,B,C), will be the number of squares needed, followed by the size you should cut. The second cut is on the diagonal, (corner to corner), to make half square triangles. If necessary, the third cut is also on the diagonal, forming quarter square triangles.

All squares in this quilt should measure 8 1/2" from unfinished edge to unfinished edge.

### BOM #3 HOMEWARD BOUND

2 colors

	CUT	SIZE	NEED
A	2 squares	4 7/8"	4 Half Square Triangles
B	2 squares	4 7/8"	4 Half Square Triangles

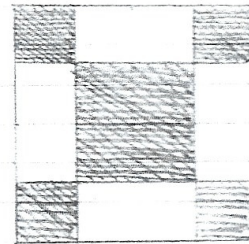


Sew one color A triangle to each color B triangle to form 4 squares. Press to the dark color. Arrange a four patch with the dark colors pointing to the top right. Sew two squares together times 2. Sew the two pairs together to form the block.

### BOM # 4 NINE PATCH VARIATION

2 colors

	CUT	SIZE	NEED
B	4 squares	2 1/2"	4 squares
B	1 square	4 1/2"	1 square
A	4 rectangles	2 1/2 x 4 1/2"	4 rectangles



Sew one small B square to each end of two rectangles A. Sew the remaining two rectangles to opposite sides of the large square B. Sew one narrow strip to the top of the large square section. Sew the remaining strip to the bottom of the above unit to form the block..
