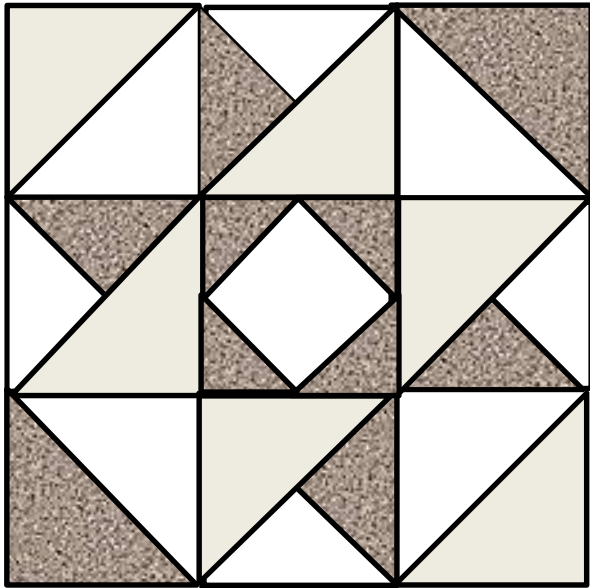


Block Ten – Ernie David Star

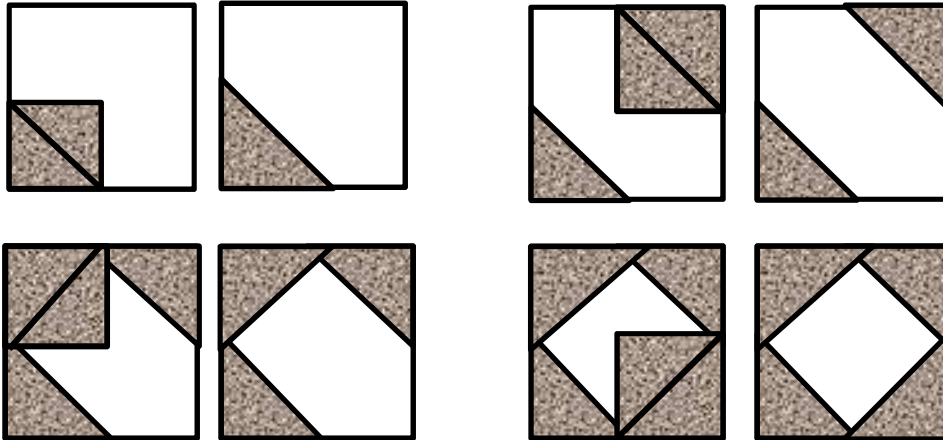


Color one (background) – cut (4) 4 7/8 inch squares, cut (2) 5 1/4 inch squares, cut (1) 4 1/2 inch square

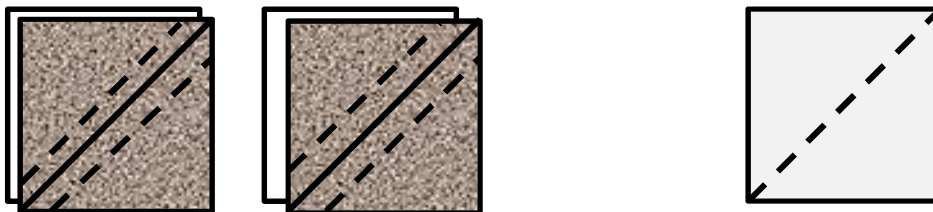
Color Two – (light gray) - cut (3) 4 7/8 inch squares.

Color Three (dark gray) - cut (1) 4 7/8 inch squares, cut (4) 2 1/2 inch squares, (2) 5 1/4 inches square.

For your center square, place one 2 1/2 inch square of color three in the corner of one 4 1/2 inch background square and sew on the diagonal: trim away the excess and press open. Do this on all four corners ...see diagram:

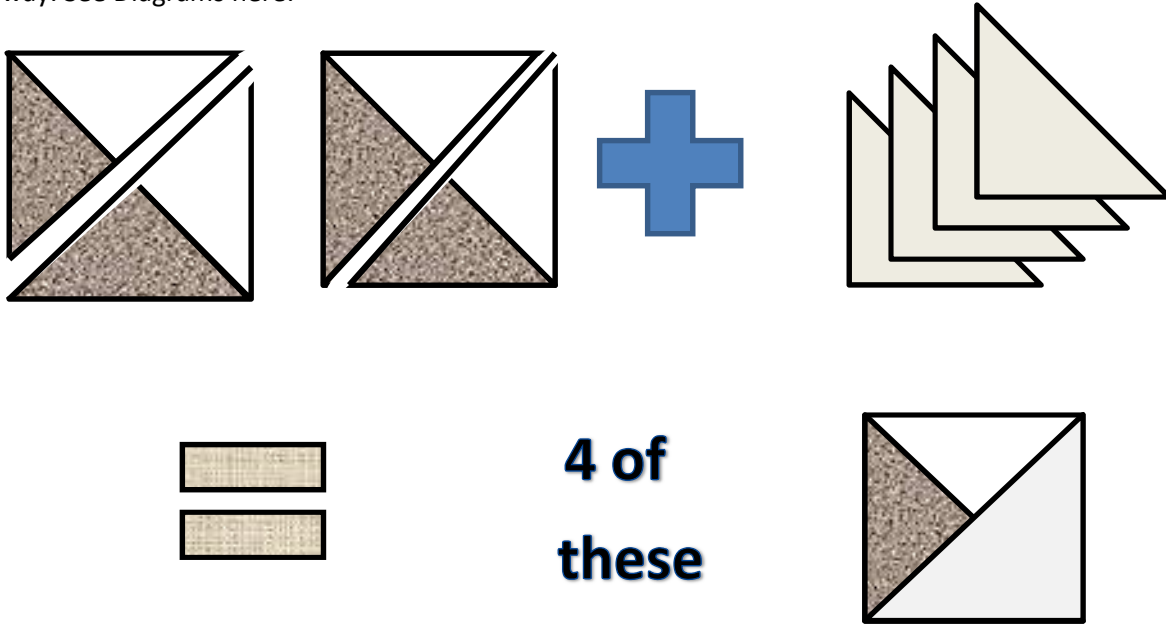


Now take your (2) 5 1/4 inch square of background and color 3. Place one each of colors 3 on each background square, right sides together, draw a diagonal line and stitch on each side of that diagonal 1/4 inch as shown below. Cut apart. Also cut you (2) 4 7/8m of color 2 diagonally once.

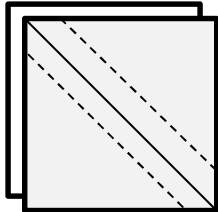


Cut apart and press open.

Now take (2) $4\frac{7}{8}$ inch squares of color 3 and two of the color 2 half square triangles units you just made. Place them right sides together, draw a diagonal and sew on either side of this diagonal $\frac{1}{4}$ inch away. See Diagrams here:



Now let's make the corner units. Take 1 of your $4\frac{7}{8}$ inch of color three and 1 background $4\frac{7}{8}$, place them right sides together, draw a diagonal line, stitch on either side $\frac{1}{4}$ inch. Cut apart and press open.



Now do the same thing with Color two and 1 background $4\frac{7}{8}$ inch squares



Now lay out your units using the first diagram, and sew them together....two more blocks next month and you are done with your BOM journey!!!!
