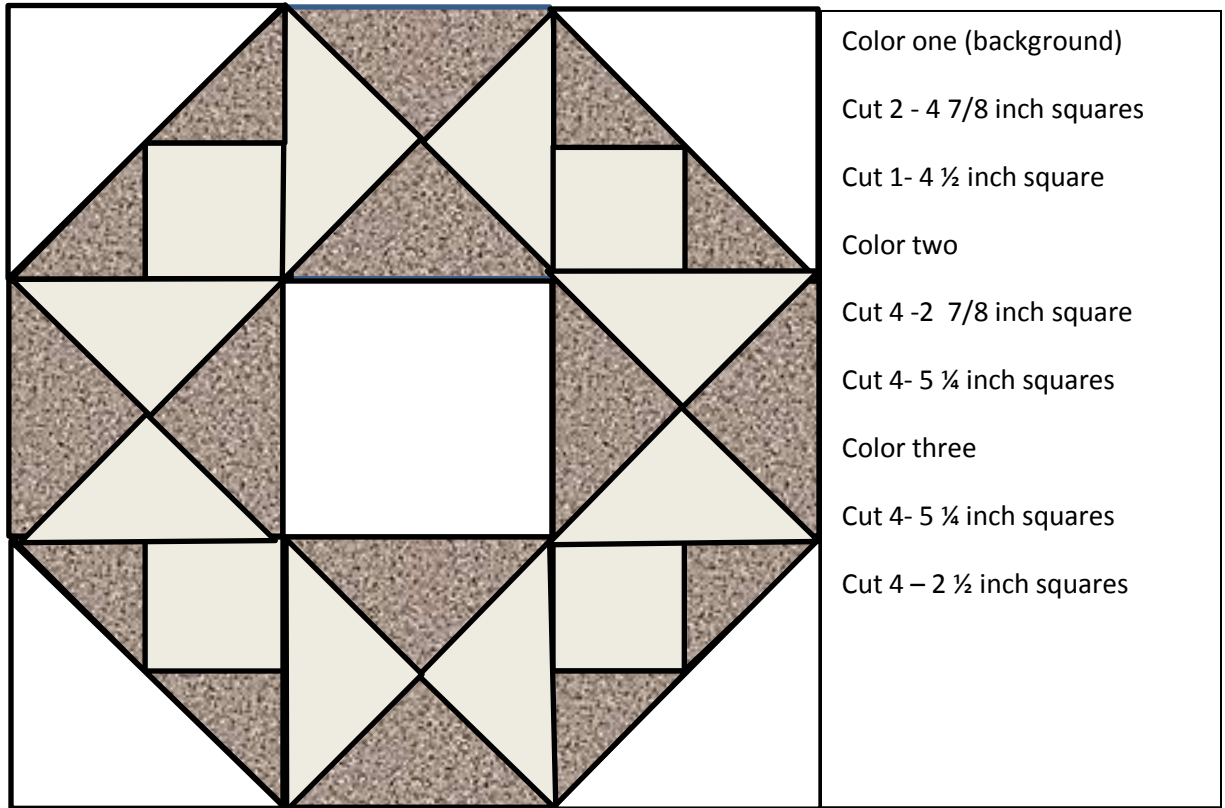
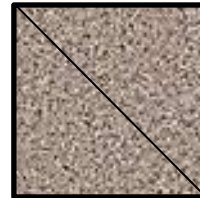


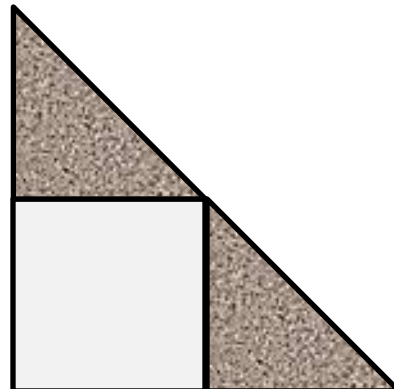
Block Twelve – Home Sweet Home



Start with Color 2 - four 2 7/8" squares. Stack and cut these in half along one diagonal to make eight half square triangles...set aside.



Sew two half square triangles on either side of your color 3 2 1/2 inch square as shown here

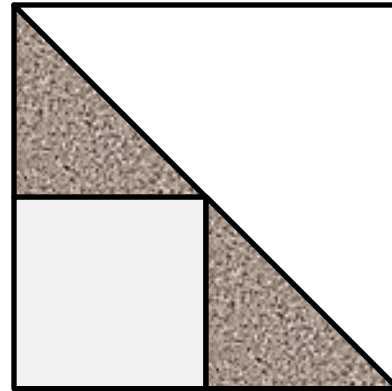


Do this to make four units.

Now cut your color one (background)  $4 \frac{7}{8}$  inch square

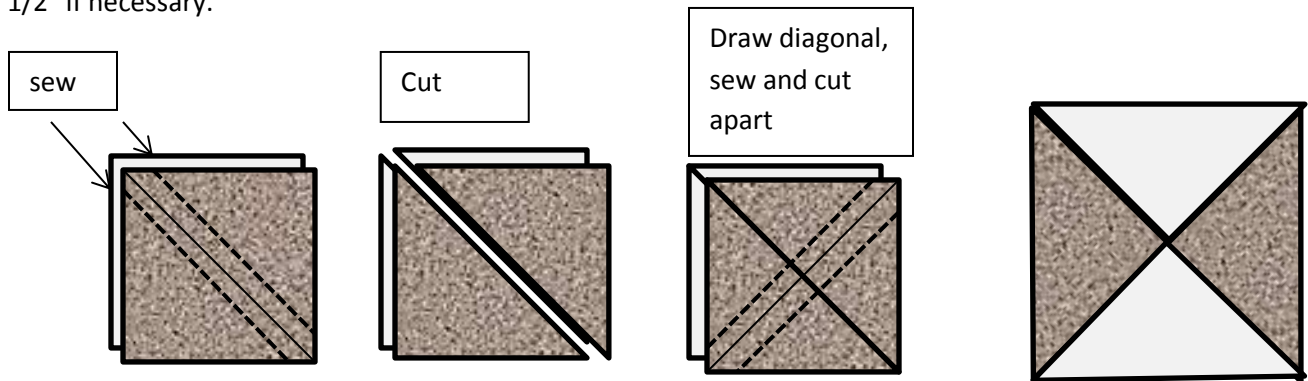
On the diagonal and sew them onto the previous units to make a square.

Make 4 of these units

Now sew the quarter square triangle units, by stacking the (4) each, Color 2 and Color 3  $5 \frac{1}{4}$  Squares, right sides together and all edges aligned. On the back, lightly mark a diagonal line, and sew  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch along each side...cut apart to make 4, then mark in the diagonals as shown above. Sew a scant  $\frac{1}{4}$ " above and below the marked diagonals, pivoting at the square lines. Cut these apart on the square lines and on the diagonal lines between the rows of stitching. Don't press them open yet! With them still flat, the way you just cut them, align a ruler from corner to corner, and cut on the OTHER diagonal. This will give you eight quarter square triangles. Press seams towards darker fabric. Sew pairs together, and trim to be  $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " if necessary.



Now lay your unit out to form the block shown on page one and stitch your units together.
