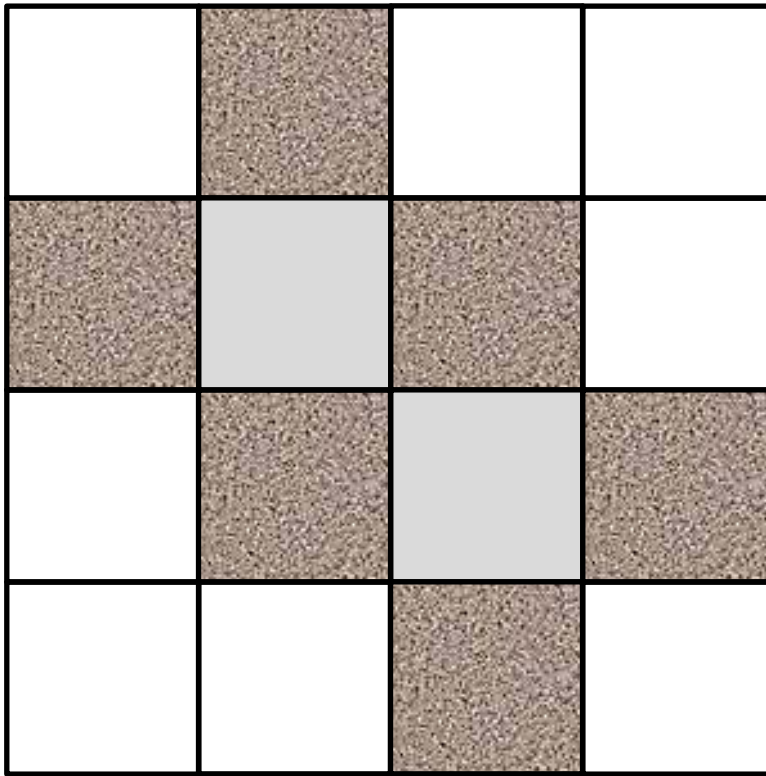


## Block two – The Chemung Arrowhead



Remember the diagonal orientation on this block and the first block when you are ready to set them into the first row. The angle of each block draws the eye to the top center of the quilt. Block one is set into the first row with a bottom left to top right orientation....and Block two is set into the first row with a top left bottom right orientation. Don't let this confuse you....just look at each block and sew them into the quilt the way they look...and ya know, if you don't, it is okay...the world will not end, the Berlin wall will not be rebuilt and you can just claim your artistic license allowed you to do as you wished!

### Cutting:

Color one (background) – cut (8) 3 ½ inch squares

Color two – cut (2) 3 ½ inch squares

Color three – cut (6) 3 ½ inch squares

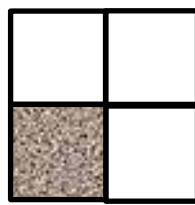
### Piecing:

I found that making four patches works best for this simple block.

Make two which look like this:



And two which look like this:



Now press then gently, arrange the four patch unit into the block illustration at the top of the page, sew, press and eat a cookie! You have no cookies?? GO BAKE SOME!
