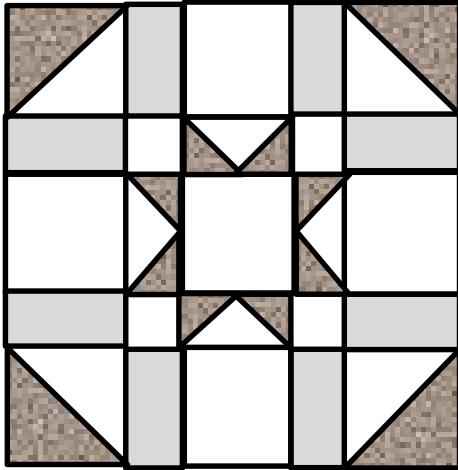


Block three – Our Hero’s Star

(Please note – on the diagrams on this page, all sewing lines are broken dash line and all cutting lines are solid lines)



Cutting:

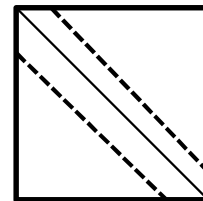
Color one (background) – cut (2) 3 7/8 inch squares; cut (4) 2 by 3 1/2 inch strips; cut (4) 2 inch squares; cut (5) 3 1/2 inch squares

Color two – cut (8) 2 inch squares; cut (2) 3 7/8 in squares

Color three – cut (8) 2 by 3 1/2 inch rectangles

Piecing

Using your (2) 3 7/8 inch squares of color1 and color2, place one of each right sides together, draw a diagonal line and stitch on both sides of that line one quarter inch seam allowances. Press and cut apart. Press. Repeat for the other set of 3 7/8 inch squares.

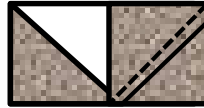


Using your (4) 2 by 3 1/2 inch strips of color 1, place a 2 inch square on one end, as shown, stitch, press and cut...press open. **DO NOT SEW YOUR SECOND SQUARE BEFORE YOU PRESS THE FIRST OPEN!**

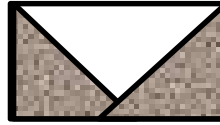
Sew, and then cut

Press open

Now place a second 2 inch square on the opposite end
and repeat.



Make four of these units.



Now layout all your units as shown in the first block diagram above. Stitch into rows, and then sew the rows together, pressing gently as necessary.

CONGRATS!!! Well you are now one quarter through your BOM blocks....are you keeping up with your alternate block construction? They are quick and easy so go do one or more!
