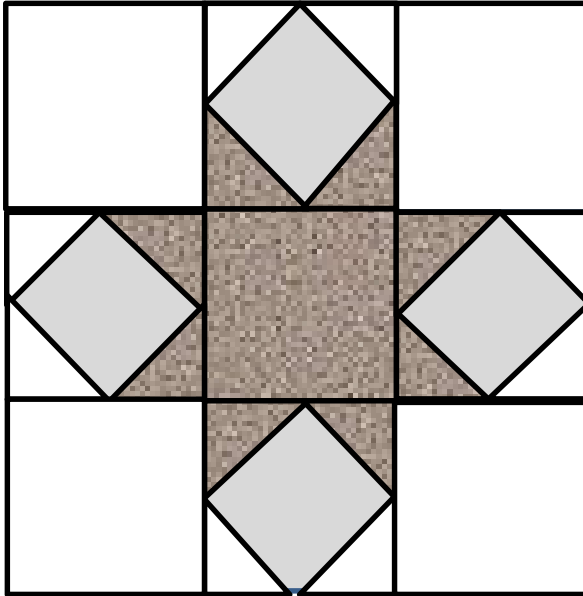


Block 4 – Star of the Valley



Cutting:

Color one (background) Cut (4) 4 ½ inch square and cut (8) 2 ½ inch squares

Color two – Cut (4) 4 ½ inch squares

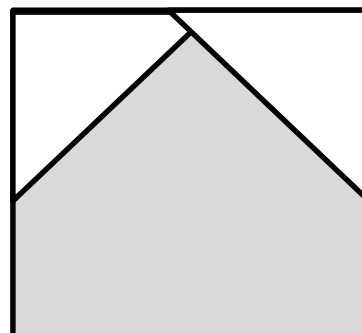
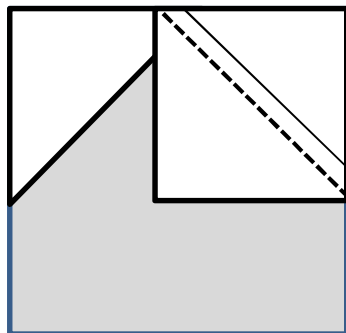
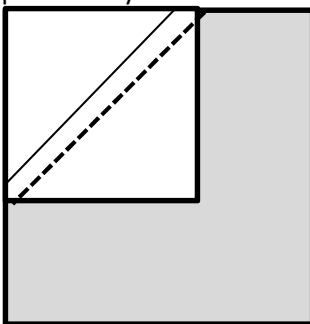
Color three – Cut (1) 4 ½ inch square and cut (8) 2 ½ inch squares

Piecing:

( Note – on this page, sewing lines are dashes and cutting lines are solid)

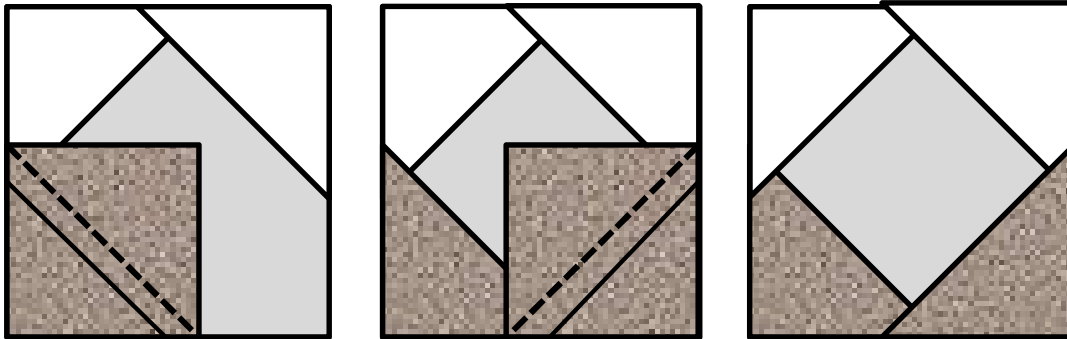
Using one of your color two 4 ½ inch square, place one color one 2 ½ inch square in the upper left hand corner, right sides together. Draw, and then sew a diagonal line as shown in the first diagram. Cut along the solid line and press open. Now place a second 2 ½ of color one on the upper right hand corner, right sides together. Draw, and then sew a diagonal line as shown in the second diagram.

Repeat until you have four units which look like the third diagram.



Now using these same unit, place a 2 ½ inch square of color three in the lower left corner of one, right sides together. Draw, and then sew a diagonal line as shown in the first diagram. Cut along the solid line and press open. Now place a second 2 ½ of color three on the upper right hand corner, right sides together. Draw, and then sew a diagonal line as shown in the second diagram

Repeat until you have four units which look like the third diagram.



Now layout all your units as shown in the block diagram above. Stitch into rows, and then sew the rows together, pressing gently as necessary.

Woooo hoooo! Block four is in the bag! Now.....make a couple alternate blocks.....you are going to need thirteen of them so don't get behind on those simple little puppies! And then go eat cookies....hey don't blame me if you gain a pound for two....I like cookies!
