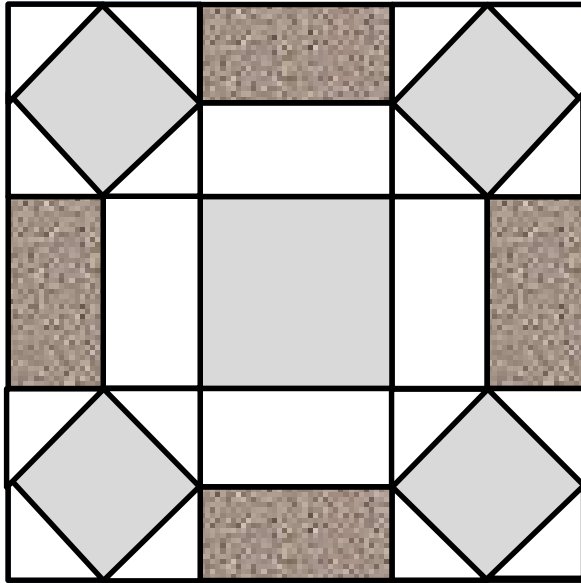


Block five – Mark Twain’s Study

(Note – on this page, sewing lines are dashes and cutting lines are solid)



Cutting:

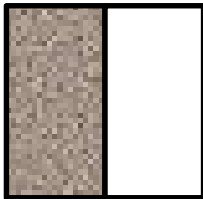
Color one (background) – cut (4) 4 ½ by 2 1/2 inch rectangles; cut (16) 2 ½ inch square.

Color two – cut (5) 4 ½ inch squares.

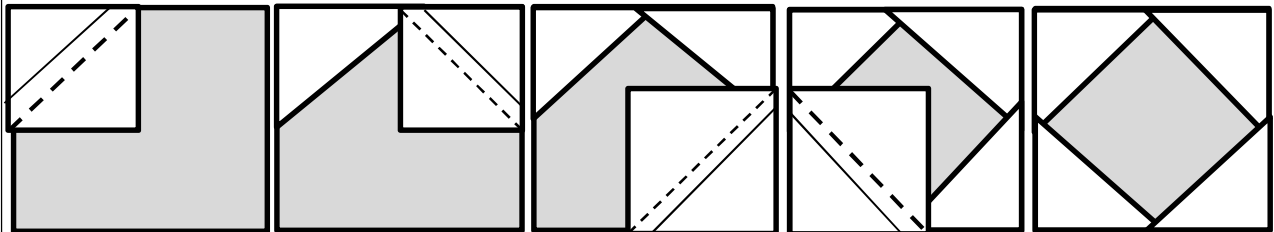
Color three – cut (4) 4 ½ by 2 ½ inch rectangles.

This is such a fun block....let’s piece:

Sew each color one rectangle to each color tree rectangle...giving you four units which look like this:



Now take on color two 4 ½ inch square. Place a color one 2 ½ inch square in the upper left hand corner, rights sides together. Draw a diagonal line and stitch on that line. Trim, open and press. Now add a second in the upper right hand corner. Sew trim, open and press. Add a third in the lower right corner. Sew, trim, open, press. And finally the fourth in the lower left corner. Sew trim open and press.



Okay we now have all our units to make the block. Lay it out using the block diagram at the top of this page as a guide...then sew your rows together and then sew the rows to each other. A light press and if you are caught up on your alternate blocks, you are free to bake....mmmmm...cookies!
