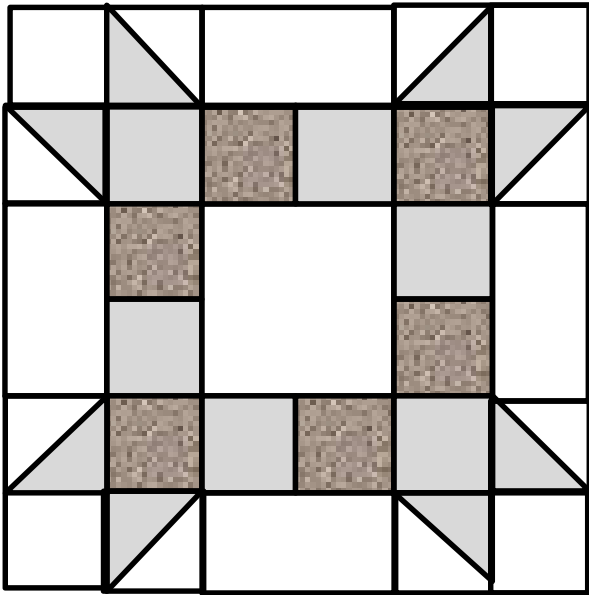


Block six – Northern Tier Star



Cutting: Color one (background) – cut (1) 4 ½ inch square, cut (4) 4 ½ by 2 ½ inch rectangles, cut (4) 2 ½ inch square, cut (8) 2 7/8 inch squares

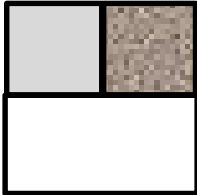
Before cutting color two, see * note below.

Color two – cut (8) 2 7/8 inch squares, cut (6) 2 ½ inch squares

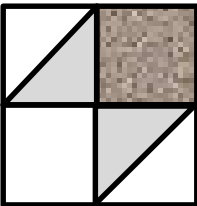
Color three - cut (6) 2 ½ inch squares.

NOTE – when selecting the fabrics for color two, if you are using a variety of reds, use one red for the star points and different red for the 2/12 inch squares.

Piecing: Select one color two 2 ½ inch square and sew it to one color three 2 ½ inch square. Then press this unit open, and sew it to one 4 ½ inch by 2 ½ inch rectangle. Repeat until you have four units which look like this



Now take one 2 7/8 inch square of color two and color one, place right sides together, draw a diagonal line, and stitch on that diagonal line. Trim ¼ inch from the sewn line, press open. Repeat until you have 8 units. Then lay out your units to look like this and stitch together.



Now position your completed units to look like the block diagram above and stitch them into rows and then stitch the rows into your completed block!

Half of your BOM blocks are now done! And you have gained a pound or 6 from all the cookie consumption ...DON'T YOU FEEL GREAT! (about the blocks I mean, not the cookie pounds)
