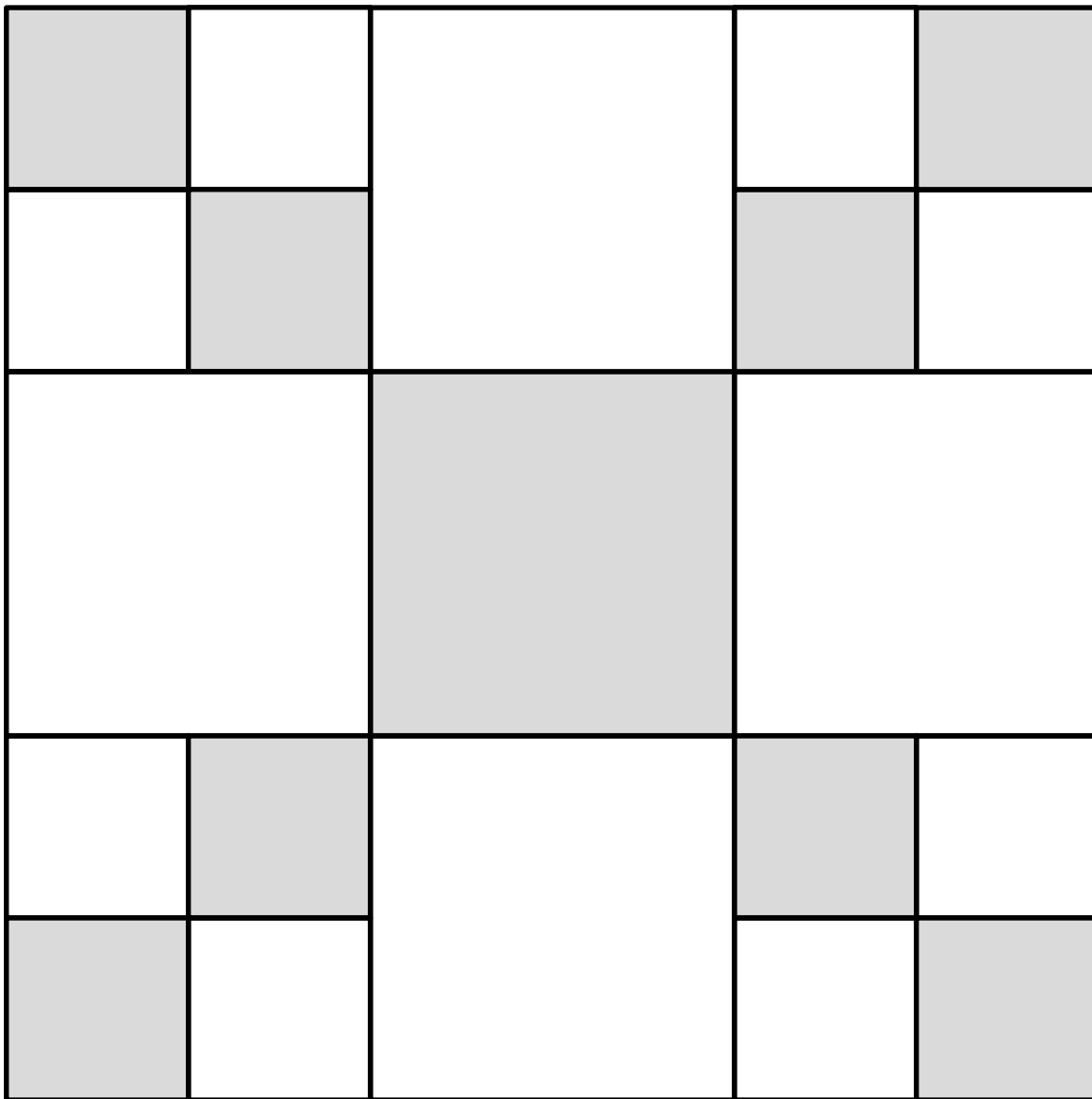


The Alternate Block – The Allegheny Crossroads



READ THIS COMPLETELY BEFORE YOU CUT PLEASEEEEE

As you can see your alternate block is a simple four patch nine patch configuration. Using Color 4 and Color 1, cut (8) 2 ½ inch squares of each. Sew (4) four patches and press. Then cut (1) 4 ½ inch square of Color 4 and (4) 4 ½ inch squares of Color 1. Arrange your block as shown above and sew.

You will need 13 of these blocks for the quilt and they can be made whenever you have ten minutes to spare....really, ten minutes! Or cut all the pieces for these blocks and use them as your leaders and ends while piecing your BOM blocks. Below are the cutting numbers if you want to cut everything at once.

Color 1 (background), cut – (104) 2 ½ inch squares, cut (52) 4 ½ inch squares

Color 4, cut (104) 2 ½ inch squares, cut 13 4 ½ inch squares.
