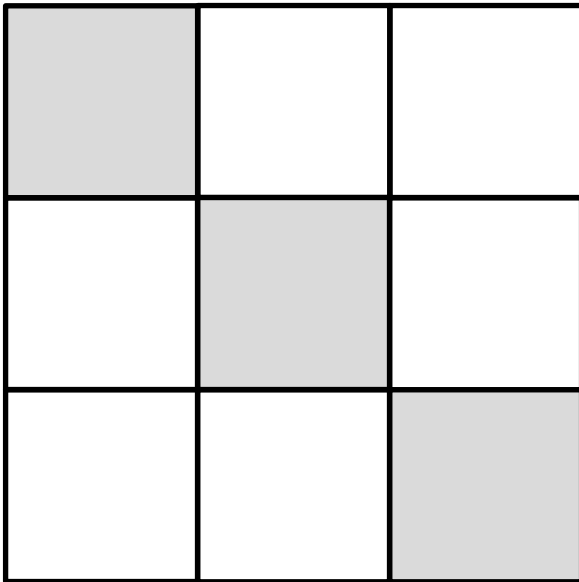


Borders – The Appalachian Hug (READ EVERYTHING FIRST)



This is a simple nine patch block made with Color one (background) and Color four. To finish off the quilt you will need to make 20 of these blocks.

To make your border, you will sew one Appalachian Hug to one sashing unit, then to one 12 ½ by 6 ½ in rectangle of background etc....see diagram below for layout of the border; a picture is worth a thousand words!



This is the setting for your top and bottom border....make two of these.



This is the setting for your side borders. Make two.

Your last border will be a 2 ½ inch strip all the way around of your background fabric. This is included in your fabric requirements listed at the beginning.

I am going to put another border of half square triangles...a saw tooth border on mine. You may wish to as well but NOTE....this is not listed in your fabric requirements in the beginning. You will need an extra 1 ¼ yards of background and color 4.

OMGOSH! Cutting instructions!

Color 1(background)-cut (12) 12 ½ by 6 ½ inch rectangles; cut (12) ½ by 2 ½ inch rectangles; cut (60) 2 ½ inch squares.

Color 4 – cut 30 2 ½ inch squares.
