

Instructions for making EMQG Nametag

Supplies:

Five squares of assorted green fabrics

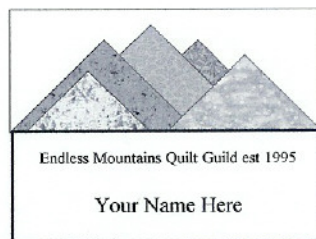
two: 2 ½" squares (points #1 and #5)

two: 2 5/8" squares (points #2 and #4)

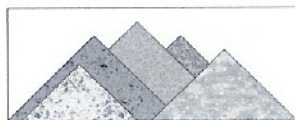
one: 3 ½" square (point #3)

Two pieces of muslin: 2- ½" x 5"

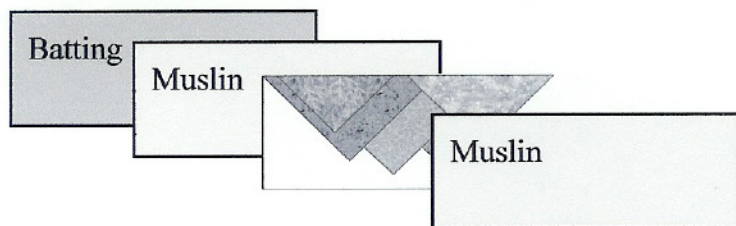
One piece light batting: 2 - 1/4" x 5"



1. Fold green squares to form prairie points. (Fold in half diagonally, then fold in half again to form a right triangle.)
#1, #3, #4 are the back points, #1, #5 are the front points
2. Lay one piece of the muslin on light sandpaper to write "Endless Mountains Quilt Guild Est. 1995" (no quotes) and your name.
3. Baste the mountains together. The back points fit inside each other from one side to the other. The width of the assembled mountains should be 4 - ½".



4. Sandwich the mountains between the two pieces of muslin, raw edges together, with the mountains centered with ¼" seam allowance on both ends. Add batting to one side of this sandwich. Sew through all layers with a ¼" seam allowance along end, across raw edge of mountains, and along other end, leaving bottom open.

5. Clip corners and turn right side out. Press. Slip stitch bottom closed.
6. Embellish as desired.
7. Add pin or ribbon to wear.
